

#### Notice of Decision

This is a notice of decision of the Northern Ireland Social Care Council (the Council).

### Decision

The Council has decided:

- 1. that there is evidence that your Fitness to Practise is impaired by reason of misconduct, as defined in Part 1, Rule 4 of the NISCC Fitness to Practise (Amendment) Rules 2019.
- 2. to issue a warning and direct that a record of the warning should be placed on your entry in the Register for a period of three years.

### Misconduct

That whilst being registered as a social care worker, and whilst employed as a Health Care Assistant at Lydian Care Agency:

- a. You submitted fraudulent timesheets for payment for shifts not worked on 21.3.22; 23.3.22; 24.3.22; 28.3.22; and 29.3.22 for your own financial gain to the sum of £336.06.
- b. Your actions as set out at 'a' were dishonest.

### Reasons

The reasons that this behaviour is considered to constitute impaired fitness to practise are:

- Your actions were dishonest;
- Your actions were fraudulent in respect of claiming monies for shifts not worked;
- Your behaviour has fallen below the standard expected of a person registered with the Northern Ireland Social Care Council.

### NISCC Standards of Conduct and Practice for Social Care Workers

The Standards of Conduct and Practice for Social Care Workers that your behaviour has breached, are as follows:

Standard 2:

As a social care worker, you must strive to establish and maintain the trust and confidence of service users and carers.

## This includes:

Standard 2.1 Being honest and trustworthy;

Standard 2.11 Not engaging in practices which are fraudulent in respect of use of public or private monies.

Standard 5:

As a social care worker, you must uphold public trust and confidence in social care services.

In particular you must not:

Standard 5.8 Behave in a way, in work or outside work, which would call into question your suitability to work in social care services;

Standard 6:

As a social care worker, you must be accountable for the quality of your work and take responsibility for maintaining and improving your knowledge and skills.

This includes:

Standard 6.12 Cooperating with any investigation or formal inquiry into your conduct, the conduct of others, or the care or services provided to a service user when appropriate.

## Sanction

Having regard to the document 'Consensual Disposal Indicative Sanctions' the Council decided that the appropriate sanction was the imposition of a warning on your registration for a period of three years.

### Reasons for the Sanction

When reaching its decision the Council considered the following factors:

- You claimed for and accepted payment for work you knowingly did not complete.
- Your actions were dishonest.
- Your behaviour was not an isolated incident but occurred on at least 5 occasions;
- You have failed to engage with Lydian Care's investigation and have failed to submit any mitigation for your actions.
- You have failed to engage with the fitness to practise investigation.
- Your behaviour has demonstrated a serious disregard for the NISCC Standards of Conduct and Practice.
- You have provided no evidence of reflection, remorse or remediation to date.

The following mitigating circumstances were taken into account in reaching this decision:

- There is no evidence of direct or indirect harm to service users.
- You have no previous record of misconduct with the Council.
